First Week of School for 2023 (3 Jan to 6 Jan)

The new 2023 school year will start on 3 Jan (Tue). To support our students in starting the new school year well, we have designed a First Week of School Programme with different activities planned for each cohort. The detailed schedule would be shared with students on the first day of school. Please note that the dismissal time for 3 Jan to 5 Jan will be earlier at 12 pm while the dismissal time for 6 Jan will be the usual 12.40 pm for Fridays.

If your child/ward has fever and/or flu-like symptoms, please consult a doctor. Your child/ward should refrain from being in school until he/she has fully recovered. Late Start Day on Thursdays

With effect from Term 1 2023, the late start day will be shifted from Wednesdays to Thursdays. Hence, the reporting time for students will be 7.30 am on all school days, except for Thursdays,

where the reporting time will be at 8.30 am instead. We have made this adjustment as many CCAs have training sessions on Wednesdays and students would appreciate a later start on the day after their CCA.

To streamline the school timetable, our regular fortnightly Home-Based Learning (HBL) Days will be on odd week Thursdays **for all levels**. Students and parents may refer to the class timetables, which will be uploaded [here](#) by 30 Dec (Fri).

Revision in School Canteen Prices

In view of the challenges faced by school canteen stallholders due to higher operating costs, MOE has revised the school canteen pricing guidelines in July 2022. This revision aims to enable canteen stallholders to sustain their livelihood while keeping school canteen food and drinks affordable for students.

After evaluating proposals by our school canteen stallholders, prices of selected items will increase in the range of \$0.10 to \$0.30 with effect from Term 1 2023.

To ensure the affordability of school canteen meals for students from lower-income families, with effect from Term 1 2023, the income eligibility criteria for the MOE Financial Assistance Scheme (FAS) will be revised (please click [here](#) for details). The school meal subsidies for secondary students under MOE FAS will also be increased from \$2.90 to \$3.50 per school meal for 10 meals per school week.

First Temperature-Taking Exercise of 2023

To maintain preparedness for temperature-taking and to educate students on taking personal responsibility for their own health, schools conduct temperature-taking exercises twice a year. The first temperature-taking exercise of 2023 will be on 11 Jan (Wed). Please ensure that your child/ward brings a working thermometer that day.

President's Award for Teachers (PAT) and Outstanding Youth Award in Education (OYEA) 2023

Every year, two categories of national awards are given out to teachers in Singapore to recognise their professional excellence. They are the President's Award for Teachers (PAT) and the Outstanding Youth in Education Award (OYEA).

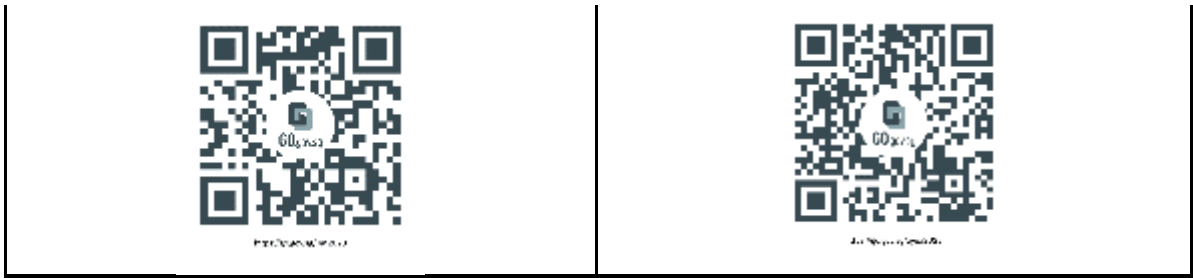
The **President's Award for Teachers (PAT)** gives national recognition to experienced teachers who are role models for the teaching profession. These teachers personify deep passion for teaching, and inspire both their students and peers through their words and deeds.

The **Outstanding Youth in Education Award (OYEA)** gives national recognition to young teachers who are role models for the teaching profession. These teachers personify youthful idealism, energy and enthusiasm, and inspire both their students and peers through their words and deeds. Educators who are 35 years and younger are eligible for the award. Hence, OYEA 2023 is open to educators who are born on or after 30 June 1988.

Nominations for PAT 2023 and OYEA 2023 are now open and will close on 11 Jan 2023 (Wed).
